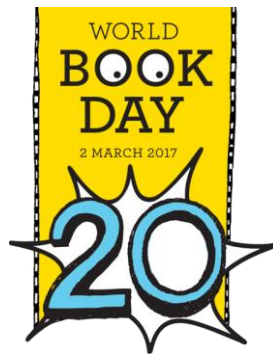
Easter Raffle
